WHAT: Fugitive Wanted for of Animal Cruelty

Crime Stoppers and its Law Enforcement Partners are looking for Tiffiney Nicole Brown who is wanted for Cruelty to Animals. Crime Stoppers is appealing to the public for any information leading to the location of Brown.

On November 29, 2010 Harris County Constables responded to a report that a Pit Bull canine was left tethered and abandoned for five days in the back patio at the residence of Tiffiney Nicole Brown. The canine appeared to be thin in weight and lacking adequate food and water. Investigators continued the investigation leaving "violation notices" attempting to make contact with the owner. A seizure warrant was issued, and the was canine brought to the Houston Humane Society for treatment. Veterinarians reported that the dog was extremely dehydrated, hungry and suffering from internal parasites including heartworms, hookworms and tapeworms. Brown was notified that she would need to appear in a civil court hearing, which she did not attend.

One warrant was issued for subject Brown. Warrant number 1752062 was issued by County Court # 7, with a 1,000 dollar bond.

Brown is described as a black female, 35 years old, 5'-11", 210 lbs. with brown eyes and brown hair. A still photo of the fugitive is attached.

Anyone with information leading to the location and arrest of the suspect is asked to contact Crime Stoppers of Houston at (713) 222-TIPS (8477).
