***Catch a Culprit* – Fugitive Wanted For Domestic Violence**



Crime Stoppers and investigators are searching for Nerys Alberto Quintanilla who is wanted on a felony warrant for aggravated assault related to a reported case of Domestic Violence.

On November 29, 2007, the 26 year old female victim contacted the Harris County Sheriff's Office regarding a case of Domestic Violence. The victim reported to Deputies, that Quintanilla, her estranged husband, broke into her residence through a window. Quintanilla began viciously attacking the victim with a screwdriver. The victim ran into a bedroom with her daughter and a male friend. Quintanilla kicked the bedroom door off its

hinges and attempted to stab the victim and her male friend with the screwdriver. The victim and her friend were able to wrestle the screwdriver away from Quintanilla. Quintanilla then ran to the kitchen, grabbed a hammer and attempted to strike both of them as they fled from the residence. He fled the scene prior to police arrival. The victim sustained several abrasions and bruises from the assault.

Quintanilla was charged with Aggravated Assault of a Family Member, and was later arrested. On June 8, 2010 Quintanilla violated the terms of his probation and warrant #1143837 was issued out of the 184th District Court with no bond.

Quintanilla's last known address is near the 400 block of Greens Road in Houston, TX.
