## Crime Stoppers News Release

**WHAT: Nathan Ferguson Wanted for Burglary of a Habitation, Aggravated Kidnapping and Failure to Appear.**



Crime Stoppers and its Law Enforcement Partners are seeking the public's assistance in locating Nathan David Ferguson.

On September 8, 2007 Nathan David Ferguson tried calling the victim, who he had dated at one time. The victim refused to answer her phone. Ferguson went to the victim's house and kicked in the front door. He grabbed the victim by her hair and dragged her into the bedroom where he hit her several times in the face. He put a knife to her throat and forced her to leave her house with him. Ferguson and the victim were stopped at a red light when two of the victim's friends pull up beside the suspect's vehicle. The two men exited their vehicle to help the victim. The victim fled from Ferguson and got into her friend's truck. They drive off but Ferguson follows then and rams their truck several times. The victim and her friends see a police car and flag it down for help. The suspect flees the scene. The victim had a large black eye from the assault.

Ferguson was charged with Burglary of a Habitation and Aggravated Kidnapping. He was arrested and released on a \$200,000 bond on May 27<sup>th</sup>, 2008. He was scheduled to appear in the 337<sup>th</sup> District Court on July 7, 2008 for a jury trial when he failed to appear in Court. Warrants 1175981 and 1175982 were issued for his arrest for Failure to Appear and Bond Jumping.

Nathan David Ferguson is a 38 year old white male. He is 5'11" tall and weighs 208 lbs with blonde hair and blue eyes. He is still believed to be in the Houston area.
