WHAT: Failure to Stop and Render Aid

Crime Stoppers and the Houston Police Department are seeking the public's help to identify a driver who struck a 15 year old pedestrian and failed to stop and render aid.

On Wednesday, January 19, 2011, at 7:15pm, a 15 year old pedestrian was playing with a friend in the 6700 block of Fairway Street. A white colored mini-van, traveling at a high rate of speed, hit the 15 year old and dragged him in the street. After the accident, the driver fled the scene and did not stop to render aid to the victim. The 15 year old sustained multiple lacerations and bruising to his head, face, and body. He is receiving treatment in the hospital and is recovering from his injuries.

The vehicle is described as a 2000-2005 white Dodge Caravan or mini-van with tinted windows and black bumper.
