### **WHAT: Information Needed in a Failure to Stop and Render Aid**

Crime Stoppers and Investigators with the Houston Police Department are seeking the public's assistance in identifying a suspect who left the scene of an accident.

On Thursday, March 24, 2011 at approximately 9:30 am, the 54 year old victim was at the intersection of 1800 Airline Drive at Cavalcade in the cross walk. The victim was walking East bound on W. Cavalcade when a red Chevrolet suburban ran over him. The victim was able to get a look at the driver for a brief moment. The driver failed to stop and check the welfare of the victim and fled the scene heading south on Airline. The victim was transported to the hospital with minor injuries.

The suspect is described as a Hispanic male, 18-20 years of age, with black short straight hair.
