WHAT: Information Needed in a Failure to Stop and Render Aid

Crime Stoppers and Investigators with the Houston Police Department are seeking the public's assistance in identifying a suspect who left the scene of an accident.

On Monday, February 28, 2011 at approximately 7:00 am, the 6 year old victim was attempting to cross the street in the 8600 block of Brookwulf Drive when a black truck hit him. The black truck was driven by an unknown suspect, who continued driving and fled the scene after the accident. The unknown suspect did not stop to render aid to the 6 year old victim. The victim was transported to the hospital with multiple bruises and injuries to his face and body.

The vehicle is only described as a black truck.
