WHAT: 4 Year Anniversary an increased reward on Hit and Run case

On the 4 Year Anniversary of the crime, Crime Stoppers and Investigators with the Houston Police Department are seeking the public's assistance in identifying the suspect who struck and killed 26-year-old David Alan Baldwin II on May 6, 2007.

On Sunday, May 6, 2007 at approximately 2:30 am, Mr. Baldwin was crossing Richmond northbound in the 1700 block when he was struck and killed by someone driving westbound on Richmond. The driver failed to stop and render aid to Mr. Baldwin. Mr. Baldwin died at the scene from massive head trauma.

Evidence left at the scene led investigators to identify the vehicle as a 2002-2006 black 4-door Nissan Altima. A photo of a similar car is attached. A photo of the victim, David Alan Baldwin, is also attached.
