### **WHAT: Information Needed in a Failure to Stop and Render Aid**

Crime Stoppers and Investigators with the Houston Police Department are seeking the public's assistance in identifying a suspect who left the scene of an accident.

On Saturday, January 8, 2011 at approximately 5:40 am, the victim was riding his bicycle northbound in the 19500 block of Lee Rd on the right side of the street. An unknown vehicle hit the victim from behind knocking him into the ditch on the side of the street. The suspect vehicle did not stop to render aid to the victim. The right side mirror from the vehicle struck the victim and the mirror cover broke off. This cover is maroon in color.

The vehicle is only described as a maroon vehicle.
