WHAT: Information Needed in a Failure to Stop and Render Aid

Crime Stoppers and Investigators with the Houston Police Department are seeking the public's assistance in identifying a suspect who left the scene of an accident.

On Sunday, May 22, 2011 at approximately 10:20 pm, the victim was crossing Highway 6 south from the west side to the east in the 2200 block of Highway 6 south. An unknown dark color midsize four door vehicle struck the victim and left the scene of the accident heading north bound on highway 6 south. The victim was transported to the hospital with a broken leg.

The vehicle is described as a dark color midsize four door vehicle possibly a Dodge Stratus.
