WHAT: Information Needed on Fatality Accident

Crime Stoppers and Harris County Sheriff's Office Hit & Run investigators are asking for the public's help on an accident that occurred on October 20, 2009 that resulted in the death of 54 year old Anthony Matthew Brown.

On Tuesday October 20th at around 1:45 in the afternoon, Anthony Brown was driving a 2002 Jeep Cherokee westbound near the 6500 block of Atascocita Road. A gray four door car, possibly a Toyota Matrix, pulled out of a private drive making a left turn into the westbound lane. The car pulled into Mr. Brown's path causing him to steer sharply to the left to avoid hitting the gray car. When he avoided the car he went into the opposite lane of traffic. He then attempted to get back into the westbound lane but lost control of his car and left the roadway. He struck a tree which caused his car to flip over. Mr. Brown was transported to Memorial Hermann Hospital where he died nine days later as a result of his injuries.

If anyone witnessed the accident or if anyone has any information on the other car they are urged to call Crime Stoppers.
