### **WHAT: Information Needed on Hit and Run – Victim Still in the Hospital**

Crime Stoppers and HPD Hit and Run Investigators are seeking the public's assistance with any information on the Saturday May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2009 hit and run that left 22 year old Diachanae Miller in the hospital.

On Saturday May 16<sup>th</sup> at around 12:30 in the morning, some one called to report that a female was left on the side of the road in the 8100 block of Hoffman near East Crosstimbers. The victim was transported to Ben Taub Hospital in critical condition. After an investigation the victim was identified as Diachanae "Nae-Nae" Miller and it was discovered that she had been hit by a car and left for dead. Ms. Miller is currently still in the hospital and her doctors are not sure she will ever walk again.
