**WHAT: Information Needed on a Hit and Run on Southwest Freeway  
Service Road**

Crime Stoppers and HPD Accident Investigators are seeking the public's assistance with any information on a hit and run accident that seriously injured the victim.

On Tuesday December 1, 2009 at around 9:40 in the evening, the victim was a passenger in a blue Chevy Trailblazer traveling north on the Southwest Freeway. The driver of the Trailblazer lost control of the car, spun out and ended up on the service road in the 9400 block of the Southwest Freeway. As the car spun out of control, the victim was ejected from the car and was thrown onto the road. A white car ran over the victim as they were lying in the road. The white car did not stop to check on the condition of the victim, who suffered broken bones and other serious injuries as a result of being run over. The make and model of the white car is unknown.
