WHAT: Information Needed on a Hit and Run

Crime Stoppers and Investigators with the Houston Police Department are seeking the public's assistance in identifying a suspect who hit and injured a man in the Medical Center on Wednesday August 11th, 2010.

On Wednesday August 11th at around 1:40 in the afternoon the victim was riding a motorcycle in the 7000 block of Fannin near Holcombe in the Medical Center. He was in the left lane traveling northbound when he was hit by a pick-up truck as it changed lanes. The truck did not stop and offer any assistance to the victim but continued traveling northbound down Fannin. The victim suffered a broken collar bone as a result of the accident.

The truck was described by witnesses as a green Ford F150 extended cab pick-up truck. It has a bedcover and a white star sticker in the middle of the back window. It also has a soccer emblem stuck in the lower right corner of the back window. Witnesses were not able to get a license plate number or a description of the driver.

If anyone has any information on this accident or knows anyone who drives a pick-up like the one described above, they are urged to call Crime Stoppers.
