WHAT: Information Needed on a Hit and Run

Crime Stoppers and Investigators with the Houston Police Department are seeking the public's assistance in identifying a suspect who hit a bicyclist and then fled the scene of the accident without offering any assistance.

On Friday September 3rd, 2010 at around 3:00 in the morning, the victim was riding his bicycle in the crosswalk in the 2700 block of Commonwealth Street. The suspect was traveling in the 1200 block of Westheimer in an older maroon compact 4 door car, possibly a Ford Escort or Buick Century. The suspect turned left on to Commonwealth going the wrong way and hit the victim. The victim struck the right side of the car and went up onto the hood hitting the windshield. His bicycle got stuck underneath the suspect's car causing possible damage to the undercarriage of the car. The victim is recovering from his injuries.
