WHAT: Investigators Seek Public's Help on the One Year Anniversary of a Hit-and-Run Death

Crime Stoppers and Investigators with the Houston Police Department's Accident Division are seeking the public's assistance with any information on a Hit and Run that occurred one year ago today.

On Wednesday, July 16, 2008, at approximately 10:45 p.m., 24-year-old Marcus Diggs was found lying face down on the sidewalk in the 11600 block of Cullen Boulevard with injuries to the back of his head and body. He was pronounced dead at the scene.

Further investigation revealed that his injuries were caused by some type of high impact, most likely being struck by a vehicle.

Crime Stoppers will pay up to \$5,000 for information called in to the 713-222-8477 tips hotline that leads to the identification, arrest and charging of any suspect in this two incident. Tips may also be submitted online at www.crime-stoppers.org. All tipsters remain anonymous.
