WHAT: Information Needed on Hit and Run Death

CASE DESCRIPTION:

Crime Stoppers and Investigators with the Houston Police Department are seeking the public's assistance for any information leading to the identification, charging or arrest of a suspect in the September 28, 2008 hit and run death of Rosa Martinez.

On September 28, 2008 around 10:30 p.m. Rosa Martinez was standing in the driveway of a house in the 3900 block of Lee Road. At that same time a Hispanic male driving a white Suburban was traveling southbound on Hutton. He then turned eastbound on Lee Road and lost control of the Suburban. Ms. Martinez did not have time to react or move out of the way and was struck by the white Suburban. The driver did not stop, nor did he render any assistance to Ms. Martinez. In fact, he continued down Lee Road and then turned northbound on Russell Street. Ms. Martinez was transported to the hospital where she died a short time later.

The only information the police have is that the car that struck Ms. Martinez is a white Chevy Suburban that was driven by a Hispanic male. The Suburban has possible front end damage. Investigators are seeking the public's help in obtaining any information on the driver of the vehicle or a possible license plate number.
