WHAT: Information Needed on a Hit and Run That Killed a Bicyclist

Crime Stoppers and HPD Accident Investigators are seeking the public's assistance with any information on the hit and run accident that killed Paul Miller.

In the early morning hours of Sunday September 6th, 2009 Paul Miller was found lying along the road in the 7200 block of the South Loop East Service Road. It appears that he was riding his bike along the south bound service road when he was hit by a car. Mr. Miller was found around 2:20 in the morning. Anyone that might have seen anything late Saturday night or early Sunday morning along that stretch of the service road is urged to call Crime Stoppers.
