WHAT: Information Needed on Hit and Run Homicide

Crime Stoppers and Investigators with the Harris County Sheriff's Office Traffic Enforcement Section are seeking the public's assistance with any information on a hit and run that occurred on Saturday November 29, 2008 that resulted in the death of Robert Roy on January 12, 2009.

On Saturday November 29, 2008 around 5:45 in the morning Robert Roy was traveling eastbound in the 1000 block of FM 1960 on his motorcycle. The suspect was traveling in the opposite direction in the same block, when the car they were driving made a left turn into a private drive in front of Mr. Roy's motorcycle causing Mr. Roy to hit the car. The suspect then left the scene without checking on the condition of Mr. Roy. Mr. Roy was transported to the hospital. He was hospitalized until January 12, 2009 when he died as a result of his injuries from the accident.

After a lengthy investigation and from evidence collected at the scene it was determined that the suspect was driving a 2000 to 2005 silver colored Chevrolet Impala.
