### **WHAT: One Year Anniversary of the Murder of Frank Roberts**

Today marks the one year anniversary of the murder of Frank Roberts. Crime Stoppers and Investigators with the Houston Police Department's Homicide Division are seeking the public's assistance with any information on his murder.

On Sunday August 30th, 2009 at around 3:30 in the morning, Frank Roberts and the suspect were in a parking lot across the street from a night club in the 1700 block of Webster in Midtown. The two got into a fight; the suspect pulled out a gun and shot Mr. Roberts. Mr. Roberts fell to the ground and the suspect shot him at least two more times. The suspect ran to a light colored SUV where a woman was waiting in the passenger seat. He got in the driver's side and drove off. Mr. Roberts died as a result of his injuries.

The suspect is only described as a black male in his late 30's. He was around 5'11" tall with a medium build. If anyone has any information on this murder they are urged to call Crime Stoppers.
