WHAT: Crime Stoppers, Houston Police Department seek information on the June 8th, 2008 Murder of Jorge Hernandez. Reward increased to \$15,000

CASE DESCRIPTION: Crime Stoppers announces an increased reward for information leading to the filing of charges and capture of a Capital Murderer. Crime Stoppers will pay up to \$15,000 for information that identifies and locates the murderer of Jorge Hernandez.

On Sunday June 8, 2008 at 10:40 p.m. Mr. Hernandez, a fuel truck driver, was stopped at the Mobil Station at 9004 North Freeway when he was approached by a black male suspect who tried to rob him. A struggle occurred and the suspect shot Mr. Hernandez several times. The suspect then fled in a dark 1996-1998 four door Cadillac driven by a second unknown black male. A female friend of Mr. Hernandez and a Good Samaritan bystander tried valiantly to save his life, but he died at the scene.

The suspect is described as a black male 18 to 20 years old with a thin build and dark complexion. He is about 5' 10" tall and was wearing a dark colored sweat suit with matching stripes down the pant's leg and jacket sleeves. He also had on a dark colored Houston Astros baseball cap with a light blue star on the front.

Attached are photos of a likeness of the car and baseball cap. Also attached is a picture of Mr. Hernandez.

Mr. Hernandez was employed by Petroleum Wholesale. In an effort to encourage the capture of this violent felon, Petroleum Wholesale has supplemented Crime Stoppers cash reward program and provided the increased funds.

Crime Stoppers and Petroleum Wholesale will pay up to \$15,000 for information called in to the Crime Stoppers 713-222-8477 tips hotline that leads to the identification, arrest and charging of any suspect in this case. All callers remain anonymous.
