WHAT: Information Needed on 2008 Murder

Crime Stoppers and Investigators with the Houston Police Department's Homicide Division are seeking the public's assistance with any information on the February 3, 2008 murder of Perkins Jones, Jr.

On Sunday February 3, 2008 around 7:00 in the morning, the body of Perkins Jones, Jr was found in the 9100 block of Woodwick. Woodwick is located south of Tidwell and East of Homestead. Mr. Jones had been shot and his body was left in the street. Mr. Jones's car was found abandoned close by on the other side of the railroad tracks from his body. The stereo in his car had been ripped out.

At this time, there is no information on any suspect or suspects in this case. Attached is a photo of Mr. Jones.
