### **WHAT: Information Needed on 2006 Homicide**

September 25<sup>th</sup> was the National Day of Remembrance for Homicide Victims. Year after year murder extinguishes the hopes and dreams of thousands of Americans. The National Day of Remembrance reminds all of us that murder impacts everyone in every community nationwide. As time passes, families and friends are left alone to struggle with their loss. The National Day of Remembrance lets survivors know that we as a community remember their tragedy and honor their courage. Crime Stoppers will be featuring a Cold Case Homicide everyday this week to commemorate the National Day of Remembrance.

Crime Stoppers and Homicide investigators with the Houston Police Department are asking for the public's help with any information on the December 23, 2006 murder of 23 year old Steven Castro.

Steven and his friends were in the parking lot of Emiliano's nightclub located in the 7700 block of Lyons after the club closed. Around 2:15 a.m. a small altercation took place among several people in the parking lot. It soon escalated into a fight in which three people were stabbed, including Steven. Steven was pronounced dead at the scene and the other two victims were taken to local hospitals.

If anyone has any information on this murder they are urged to call Crime Stoppers. Attached is a picture of Steven Castro.
