**WHAT: Crime Stoppers, HPD Homicide Investigators Need Public's Help in Unsolved Murder**

**Case Description:**

31-year-old Tamika Russell's body was discovered in the master bedroom closet of her apartment at 8800 South Braeswood on October 11, 2005 after several days of complaints of a strong odor coming from the apartment. It appeared she had been dead several days due to her body's advanced stage of decomposition.

Investigators said bloodstains and the general disarray of the closet indicated that Ms. Russell put up a struggle before being murdered.

Investigators have exhausted all leads on Ms. Russell's death, and are asking the public for any information that may lead to solving her murder.

Crime Stoppers will pay up to \$5,000 for information leading to the arrest and charging of any suspect in this case. Anyone with information on Tamika Russell's homicide is urged to call Crime Stoppers at 713-222-TIPS (8477). All callers remain anonymous.
