WHAT: Suspects Wanted for Aggravated Robbery at Several Subways

Crime Stoppers and Investigators with the Harris County Sheriff's Office are seeking the public's assistance in identifying two suspects responsible for several Subway aggravated robberies.

On Wednesday, January 12, 2011, at approximately 9:45 pm, two black male suspects entered the Subway located at 230 Cypresswood Drive armed with guns. The suspects jumped over the counter and demanded cash from two employees. The suspects stole an undisclosed amount of cash from the registers as well as personal property from the victims.

Robbery Investigators believe the same armed suspects are responsible for two other aggravated robberies at Subway restaurants near the area. On Sunday, January 30, 2011, the Subway located at 1401 Spring Cypress Road and the Subway located at 20530 North Freeway were robbed. The victims in both cases told deputies a black male suspect entered the restaurant armed with guns and demanded the cash.

Surveillance cameras at the Subway located at 230 Cypresswood Drive captured images of the suspects. Attached are several still photos of the suspects. The two suspects are described as black males, one with a dark complexion and one with a light complexion.
