WHAT: Suspect Wanted for Aggravated Robbery

Crime Stoppers and Robbery Investigators with the Harris County Sheriff's Office are seeking the public's assistance in identifying a suspect wanted in connection with an armed robbery at a Bank of America ATM machine.

On Wednesday, February 23, 2011, at approximately 8:15 P.M., the victim was at the drive-thru ATM at the Bank of America located at 3107 Fry Road when a black male suspect approached his vehicle. The suspect pointed a handgun at the victim and threatened to kill him. The suspect stole cash, credit/debit cards, truck/house keys, and a cellular telephone before fleeing.

Surveillance cameras captured the suspect exiting a White SUV, possibly a Chevy Yukon. Cameras also captured a tattoo on the suspect's left hand, between the thumb and index finger, of a "STAR".

The suspect is described as a Black male, 20-30 years of age, 5'09"-5'11" weighing 150-170 lbs, with a short afro style brown hair and clean shaven.

The suspect vehicle is described as a White SUV possibly a Chevy Yukon.
