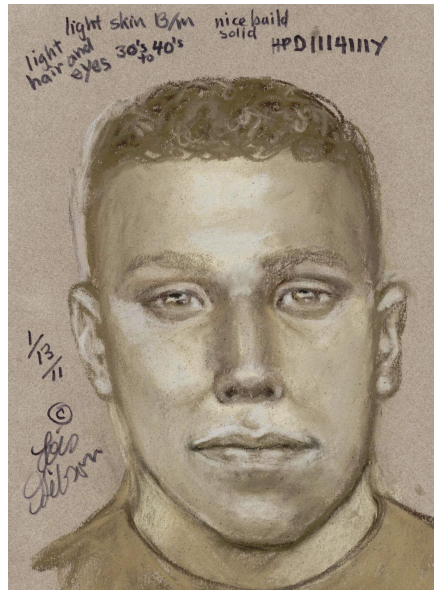

## WHAT: Robbery and Bodily Injury at a Church

Crime Stoppers and Investigators with the Houston Police Department are seeking the public's assistance in identifying two suspects wanted for robbery and bodily injury in the parking lot of the Assumption Catholic Church located at 901 Rose Lane.

On Monday, January 3, 2011, at approximately 2:00pm, the female victim and witness were leaving the Assumption Catholic Church with a large quantity of church funds. The victim and witness were entering their vehicle when the suspects drove to their vehicle in a Dodge Caravan. Suspect #1 jumped out of the backseat of the van and knocked the victim to the ground causing injuries to her nose, arm, and leg while Suspect # 2 waited in the van. The suspects stole the church funds and fled the scene in the van.

Suspect # 1 is described as being less than six feet tall, 5'07"-05'08", weighing 160-175 lbs, brown eyes, black hair, and dark brown complexion and was wearing a black du-rag.

Suspect # 2 the driver of the van is described as being bi-racial or Creole and well dressed.

The vehicle was stolen from the spring area and was later recovered.

Composite sketches of the suspects are attached. Anyone with information as to the identity of these suspects is asked to call Crime Stoppers. Callers will be anonymous.
