WHAT: Suspects wanted for Aggravated Robbery

Crime Stoppers and Robbery Investigators with the Houston Police Department are seeking the public's assistance in identifying two suspects wanted for aggravated robbery.

On Wednesday, June 1, 2011, the victim was returning to his business located in the 3300 block of Lyons. When he exited his vehicle to unlock the gate, two black male suspects approached him. Suspect # 1 had a gun and Suspect # 2 had a taser. Suspect # 2 attempted to taser the victim, who then dropped his keys and fled on foot into the business to push the panic alarm. The two suspects then fled in the victim's vehicle Northbound on Gregg Street. HPD officers located the victim's stolen vehicle in the 3700 block of Harriman.

Suspect #1 is described as a Black male between 20-25 years of age, 6'00" to 6'10", and weighing 190 to 200 lbs.

Suspect # 2 is described as a Black male between 20-25 years of age, 5'05" to 5'07", and weighing 140 to 150 lbs.
