### **WHAT: Suspects Wanted for Aggravated Robbery with Deadly Weapon**

Harris County Robbery Investigators are hoping the public can identify the suspect above who used a stolen credit card after committing a violent robbery at a Harris County cell phone store with another unknown suspect.

On June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2011, two unknown black male suspects entered the store located in the 7000 block of Addicks Clodine Road and pretended to be customers. While one of the suspects selected a phone, the other suspect leaped over the counter with a pistol. The suspects robbed the victim of his personal belongings at gunpoint, dragged him to a restroom, hit him in the head, tied up his wrists and left him there. The suspects left the scene with numerous pieces of merchandise and the victim's personal belongings.

On the same day of the robbery, surveillance cameras captured the suspect above using the victim's stolen credit card to pump gas at a gasoline station located in the 6000 block of Scott Street.

Both suspects are described as 30-35 years old, 6'01" – 6'03", 240-270 lbs, both with a muscular build
