## Crime Stoppers Press Release



### **WHAT: Armed Suspect Sought in Aggravated Robbery**

Crime Stoppers and investigators with the Harris County Sheriff's Office are searching for a man involved with an aggravated robbery at a Houston area gas station.

On Wednesday, December 21, 2011 at approximately 2:20 am, a single suspect entered a gasoline station located near the 7000 block of West F.M. 1960. The suspect entered the store, and approached the counter brandishing a firearm. The suspect demanded cash from the registers, and gave the employee five seconds to clear the drawers of their contents. As the suspect counted down from five, the victim complied with his demands and surrendered an undisclosed amount of cash. The suspect demanded a pack of cigarettes before fleeing the scene on foot.

The suspect is described as a Black male, approximately 25 years old, 5'6"-5'8", weighing 175-180 lbs with a thin beard and sideburns. At the time of the offense he was wearing a black knit cap with a logo on the front, a dark hooded jacket, black gloves, plaid pants and tan shoes.

Surveillance cameras captured the suspect arriving to the store in a four door vehicle and exiting on the passenger side. No description of the driver is currently available.
