

## Crime Stoppers News Release



### **WHAT: AGGRAVATED ROBBERY SUSPECT SOUGHT BY CRIME STOPPERS**

Crime Stoppers and investigators with the Harris County Sheriff's Office are asking for the public's assistance identifying the suspect responsible for an aggravated robbery earlier this month.

On Wednesday, January 11, 2012, at approximately 12:50 pm, an unknown black male suspect entered a payday loan store located on the 2300 block of Fry Road in Harris County. The suspect approached the counter of the business and inquired about a loan. As the clerk began to comment, the suspect withdrew a pistol, pointed it at the victim and demanded cash. The victim complied with the suspect's demands, and surrendered an undisclosed amount of cash. The suspect forced the victim into the business' back office where he demanded more cash prior to fleeing the scene.

The suspect is described as a Black male, approximately 18-25 years old, 5'7"-5'9", weighing 150-175 lbs. At the time of the offense the suspect wore a gray hooded sweatshirt, a white striped shirt, dark pants and white shoes.
