

## Crime Stoppers News Release



### **WHAT: Suspect Sought in Aggravated Robbery**

Crime Stoppers and investigators with the Houston Police Department are searching for the suspect involved in an aggravated robbery that took place in early December.

On Tuesday, December 6, 2011 an unknown black male suspect entered a discount store located on the 9500 block of Homestead in Houston. At approximately 2:00 pm the suspect approached the register and pointed a black handgun with a red laser at a store employee. The suspect demanded the money from the register and additional items. The victim complied with the suspect's demands, and was then forced to the back of the store. The suspect fled the store, but was later seen near the apartment building located on the 9000 block of Crofton.

The suspect is described as a black male, between the ages of 20 and 25 years, approximately 5'2"-5'5" tall. At the time of the offense he wore a black hooded sweatshirt and a red watch cap.
