WHAT: Aggravated Robbers Sought

CASE DESCRIPTION:

Crime Stoppers and Investigators with the Houston Police Department's Robbery Division are seeking the public's assistance in locating 3 men who kidnapped and robbed a victim on October 25th, 2008.

Around 11:00 pm on Saturday October 25th, as the victim was leaving Cyndi's Bar located in the 11200 Block of Hempstead Hwy he was approached by 3 Hispanic males. They forced him into a car and drove him to the Compass Bank at 2101 Mangum. As they threatened him with a knife, they used his ATM card to withdraw money from the machine at the bank. He was then released unharmed.

Police were only able to obtain a description and photo of one of the suspects. He is described as a Hispanic male in his twenties. He is 5'4" to 5'7' tall and weighs between 120 to 140 pounds. The other two are described as Hispanic males between 19 to 23 years old. The car used in the abduction and robbery was of an unknown make and model.

Attached is a photo of one of the suspects taken from the ATM machine at the Compass Bank.
