WHAT: Fireworks Stand Robbed



Crime Stoppers and Investigators with the Harris County Sheriff's Office Robbery Division are seeking the public's assistance in locating four men who robbed the Big Hit Fireworks Stand located at 1955 Gears Road.

On Monday December 28th, 2009 at around 9:30 in the evening two black males in a white four door Lincoln car with tinted windows and chrome wheels pulled up to the Big Hit Fireworks Stand. Two Black males got out of the car and approached the stand. They began asking the clerk about fireworks. Two more Black males approached the stand and one produced a gun. All four suspects stole the victim's personal property, cash from the stand and fireworks.

A surveillance camera from a nearby store captured one of the suspects as he entered the store. The camera also captured him running toward the Fireworks Stand and helping the other three suspects rob the victim. All four suspects are described as Black males between the ages of 18 and 25 years old. All four were between 5'6" and 6'1" tall and weighed around 160 to 180 pounds.

Two of the suspects were seen in a white four door Lincoln with tinted windows and chrome wheels. The rear license plate was mounted near the rear window. The other two suspects were in a dark colored four door vehicle that was captured on the surveillance camera.
