WHAT: Suspect Sought in Aggravated Robbery with a Deadly Weapon

Crime Stoppers and robbery investigators with the Harris County Sheriff's Office need the public's help in identifying a suspect who may be responsible for several robberies of Houston area pharmacies.

On August 30, 2011 deputies responded to an alarm call from a pharmacy located near the 8200 block of N. State Highway 6 for a reported aggravated robbery. Deputies met with the victim, a 46 year old male. They were told that just after midnight, a white male approached the pharmacy counter. The suspect presented the victim with a note demanding specific prescription medications. The suspect then lifted his shirt to reveal a gun in his waistband. The suspect verbally demanded specific medications and the victim complied, handing him several bottles of an unknown prescription drug. The suspect fled the scene on foot.

The suspect is described as a white male, 25-35 years old, approximately 6'0", 180-190 lbs, with brown hair. At the time of the offense, he was wearing a two tone black/white baseball cap, blue t-shirt, dark work style pants and dark shoes.

Robbery investigators believe that the same suspect may be responsible for several other pharmacy robberies near the area where demand letters were presented. A photo of the suspect is attached.
