WHAT: Robbers Hit 3 Possibly 4 Cash America Pawn Shops

Crime Stoppers and Harris County Sheriff's Robbery investigators are asking the public's help in identifying and locating three suspects who are wanted for at least 3 aggravated robberies at Cash America Pawn Shops.

The three suspects walk into the Cash America Pawn Shops near closing time with their faces covered by ski-masks or bandanas. They demand money from the cash drawers and safes. In one robbery they forced the customers in the store to empty their pockets and stole personal items from them. And in another robbery the suspects stole several guns from a display case.

The robberies occurred on Friday July 31, 2009 at the store located at 717 Normandy, on Tuesday August 4, 2009 at the store located at 9801 Airline and on Wednesday August 5, 2009 at the store located at 13837 Nimitz. These three suspects are possible suspects in a fourth robbery that is being investigated by the Houston Police Department that occurred on Wednesday August 12, 2009 at the store located at 5219 Airline.

The suspects are three black males, 2 are between 20 to 25 years old and one appears to be in his late twenties. Two are between 5'10" to 6'0" and the third is 6'1" to 6'3" tall. The tallest of the three weighs between 180 to 200 pounds and the other two are between 140 to 160 pounds. Witnesses to one of the robberies saw the suspects get into a silver car possibly a Mazda.

Surveillance cameras captured the suspects on video. Attached are the video and photos of the three suspects.
