WHAT: Suspect Wanted for Aggravated Robbery

Crime Stoppers and Investigators with the Harris County Sheriff's Office are seeking the public's assistance in identifying a man who robbed a Subway located in the 8000 block of N. Sam Houston Parkway.

On Monday October 4, 2010 at around 4:00 in the afternoon the suspect walked into the Subway and ordered a sandwich. He went to the restroom where he stayed for a few minutes. When he walked out of the restroom he approached the counter to pay but pulled up his shirt and showed the employee a gun stuck in his waistband. He demanded money and threatened to shoot the victim if he did not comply. The victim handed the suspect an undisclosed amount of cash and he walked out. He left the scene in a red SUV possible a Ford Explorer or GMC Envoy.

The suspect is a white male in his early 20's. He is around 6'0" to 6'02" tall and weighs between 180 to 200 pounds. He had on dark sunglasses, black cap, black shirt, black shorts, black shoes and acne on his nose. This suspect may be wanted in connection with several other robberies in the area.
