WHAT: Crime Stoppers, HPD Burglary & Theft Investigators Seek Identity of Suspect in Burglary, Credit Card Fraud

Case Description:

Crime Stoppers and HPD investigators are asking the public's help in identifying an individual who used stolen credit cards taken in a burglary July 3, 2007 at approximately 4:00 p.m.

The victim reported the theft of credit cards and other personal property from their residence in the 800 block of 27th Street in the Heights.

The attached photos from surveillance video at a nearby Shell station around 5:00 p.m. the same date show a white male, about 30-35 years old with a mustache, wearing a white t-shirt, jeans and an orange ball cap as he purchased several items with one of the stolen cards. This same individual used the cards to purchase other items at several home improvement stores.

Crime Stoppers will pay up to \$5,000 for information leading to the arrest and charging of any suspect in this case. Anyone with information on this case is urged to call Crime Stoppers at 713-222-TIPS (8477). All callers remain anonymous.
