**WHAT:            Crime Stoppers, HPD Fraud Investigators  
Looking for “Cloned-Card” Culprit**

**CASE DESCRIPTION:**

Crime Stoppers and HPD Fraud investigators are asking the public’s help in identifying and arresting a suspect who used a “cloned” credit card to purchase over \$340 worth of merchandise March 6, 2008.

The suspect is a Hispanic female, approximately 5’5” tall, 150-175 pounds. She had long brown hair, and what appears to be a tattoo on her left shoulder. She was wearing dark pants and a dark v-neck sleeveless top.

The suspect entered the Hibbert Sports store in Almeda Mall at 12:52 p.m. She spent almost an hour looking at various merchandise throughout the store. At 1:05 p.m., she bought three pair of shoes valued at \$340.98 with a credit card that was created using another person’s JP Morgan-Chase account information.

Crime Stoppers will pay up to \$5,000 for information called in to the 713-222-8477 tips hotline that leads to the identification, arrest and charging of any suspect in this case. All callers remain anonymous.
