WHAT: Crime Stoppers, HPD Investigators Seek to Arrest Major Forgery Offenders

Crime Stoppers and HPD Forgery Investigators are asking the public's help in capturing two women caught on camera while on a spending spree with someone else's money.

On Wednesday, May 9, 2007, thieves broke into a woman's vehicle in Houston and took her purse, which contained her checkbook. The two black females featured here forged a check on May 31, 2007 to purchase small items and a \$500 gift card at a Home Depot store in Webster. On June 2, 2007 the same two women used the gift card to make purchases at another Home Depot store.

June 2, 2007, the women also forged another check at a Wal-Mart on College Park Drive in The Woodlands to purchase small items and a \$400 gift card. On June 3, 2007, the women used the gift card at another Wal-Mart on Wallisville Road in East Houston.
